Friends of the Bronxville Public Library Make Additional Gift to Temporarily Reinstate the Library's Saturday Morning Hours

Generous donations by local residents and merchants have allowed The Friends to give additional funding to the Library, enabling the temporary reinstatement of Saturday morning hours, 9:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m., from February 6th through May 29th. This allows the Library to be open from 9:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Saturdays. Due to village-wide budget cuts in this difficult year, the Library has not been open on Saturday mornings. As a result, the Library staff on duty has been serving as many as 350 plus people in just four hours (almost 90 people an hour). This gift will give the public increased access and enable the Library to more effectively serve the needs of its patrons. This gift also enables the Library to purchase new books and audio-visual materials that had been previously removed from the budget.

Additional monies were raised in part by the recent Fancy Nancy Tea Party Fundraiser at The Bronxville Field Club, The Shopping Night Fundraiser held in conjunction with local merchants, and the Buy A Book collaboration with Womrath Book Store. **Details about these events and other upcoming programs at the library can be found at www.bronxvillelibraryfriends.org.**
